



Terms and Conditions

Instant MTD VAT Submission Software ("Instant MTD") is owned and made available by Cosnetics Limited ("Cosnetics") for the purpose of allowing end users to submit digital VAT return to HMRC as part of the Making Tax Digital.

1. Application of Conditions of Use

By accessing or using any part of Instant MTD you agree to be bound by the conditions of use. If you do not wish to be bound by these conditions, you may not access or use Instant MTD.

We may change these conditions at any time without any notice to you. By your continued access and use of Instant MTD you agree to be bound by the most current version of the conditions of use. Please check these conditions periodically for any changes that have been made.

2. Software licence and rights

2.1 Cosnetics grants you a royalty-free, worldwide, non-transferable non-exclusive licence to use Instant MTD software. You have the right to authorise employees, agents and third party consultants and contractors to use the Software provided that such use is consistent with these conditions of use.

2.2 You do not have any right, title, interest or intellectual property rights in the Software except as expressly set out in clause 2.1;

2.3 We do not operate an open source policy and you will not yourself, or through any parent, subsidiary, affiliate agent or other third party:

2.3.1 copy the Software

2.3.2 sell, lease or sublicense the Software or the documentation connected with it;

2.3.3 reverse engineer or decompile the Software for the purpose of developing derivative software.

4. Disclaimer of representations and warranties

4.1 The Instant MTD is provided by Cosnetics on an 'as is' and 'as and when available' basis to users. You use it at your own risk.

4.2 Neither Cosnetics nor any of its officers, directors, shareholders, employees, affiliates, third



party content providers, sponsors, licensors, or the like, makes any representation or warranty or condition, either express or implied, to you:

4.2.1 that the Instant MTD software will be error-free;

4.2.2 that the Instant MTD software is free of viruses or other harmful components.

5. Limitation of Liability

5.1 Cosnetics does not seek to limit or exclude liability for death or personal injury arising from their negligence.

5.2 Under no circumstances will Cosnetics or any of its officers, directors, shareholders, employees, affiliates, agents, sponsors, licensors, or any other party involved in the creation, production, maintenance or distribution of Instant MTD be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages (including but not limited to loss of profits, business, anticipated savings, goodwill, use of data or other intangible losses) that result from either:

5.2.2 the use and reliance on Instant MTD; or

5.2.3 the inability to use Instant MTD; or

5.2.4 mistakes, omissions, interruptions, suspension, termination, deletion of files or e-mail errors, defects, viruses, delays in operation, transmission or service response time, or any failure of performance with respect to Instant MTD including without limitation those arising from acts of God, communications failure, theft, destruction or unauthorised access to Cosnetics records, programs or services; or

5.2.5 any information, data, text, messages and other materials that you email, post upload, reproduce, transmit or is otherwise distributed using Instant MTD

5.3 Cosnetics is unable to ensure or guarantee the security of any information transmitted over the Internet. Any information or data which you transmit or is otherwise distributed by using Instant MTD is done at your own risk and Cosnetics shall not be responsible or liable for any damages or injury that may result from transmitting such information.

5.4 If any jurisdiction does not allow the exclusion or limitation of liability for consequential or incidental damages, liability is limited to the fullest extent permitted by law.

5.5 These conditions constitute the entire agreement between you and Cosnetics with respect to the subject matter hereof. If any provision contained in these conditions is determined by a court



of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, invalid or otherwise unenforceable, that provision shall be severed from these conditions and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
